In 2012. Both Lila and Maureen have served on the Reflexology Association of America Board.

On December 17, 2012, the State of Wisconsin, Department of Financial Institutions, Division of Corporate and Consumer Services. approved and filed the IRW's Articles of Incorporation—Nonstock Corporation.

On May 3, 2014, the Integrated Reflexologists of Wisconsin, Inc. became the 19th state to affiliate with the Reflexology Association of America (RAA). Wisconsin is recognized nationally for our state organization and now we have input through our Delegates to RAA.

Our organization has become a tax exempt 501(c)(6) corporation as of May 19, 2014.
